What is published at Turku University of Applied Sciences and why?

Publishing activities are part of research and development operations. Their purpose is to communicate the results of research, development and innovation operations carried out at Turku UAS, as well as the competence and expertise of its staff and students.

The goal is to produce publications of scientific interest, and gain visibility for the results of our operations and expertise in professional media. The publications should also help bring out Turku UAS's professional competence in view of the region's daily needs.

We encourage open access and parallel storage in publication activities. Compliance with open access principles means making publications permanently and freely accessible on the Internet. Turku UAS emphasises open access in its publication series and other publication channels. Articles written by our staff are also stored in the Turku UAS publication archive (Theseus).

High-quality publication operations support the brand and impact of Turku UAS. Publication is one of the performance indicators for funding for universities of applied sciences.
