Turku Castle

Turku Castle, one of Finland's most coveted pieces of national heritage and one of the country's oldest buildings, was built in the late–1200s during Finland's Swedish period.




Turku Cathedral

This is the seat of the Archbishop of Finland and the country's national sanctuary, and it is a hugely significant building. This 13th-century cathedral is widely regarded as Finland's most significant historic build.



Ruissalo Park

Ruissalo Island, situated on the upper side of the Turku estuary, is long and craggy. Getting on a bike and crossing the Ruissalon puistotie bridge is a perfect way to see Ruissalo's rugged coastline, botanical garden, sandy beaches and new ook forests.



Turku Archipelago

The Archipelago Sea, which is situated near Turku, is home to 40,000 islands, many of which are no bigger than a tennis court. You can access most of them by taking ferries.



Teijo National Park is one of Finland's must-see parks. It is also a place of life with a multitude of animal and plant species.




Enjoy the Teijo landscape on your own or with a guided tour. There are a total of about 50 kilometres of marked trails.

At one point, the bunker housed 16 soldiers. The bunker is also armed with a 45-millimetre armoured gun and a machine gun. .



INGREDIENTS FOR 8-10 PIECES

For the rice stuffing:

- 150g short grain rice
- 300g water
- 50g unsalted butter
- 1L whole milk
- Salt to taste

For the dough:

- 100g whole rye
- 50g spelt flour or wheat flour instead
- 3g salt
- 75g **-** 85g water
- 15g butter melted
- 50g butter for brush

For egg butter:

- 4 large boiled eggs
- 120g unsalted butter at room temperature
- Salt to taste
- Pepper to taste

Make the rice stuffing:

- 1) In a saucepan pour the water, place it over medium heat and let it boil.
- 2) Add the rice and cook for 5 minutes. You will notice that it absorbs practically all the water.
- 3) Add the butter together with the milk and reduce to low heat. Cook for about 45–50 minutes, stirring from time to time. You should take a smooth, thick texture.
- 4) Once the rice is ready, salt to taste, mix and let cool completely before filling the pies.

Make the dough:

- 1) In a bowl, add the rye flour together with the spelt or wheat flour, salt, water and melted butter. Mix with a silicone spatula to get a more or less compact mixture.
- 2) Keep working the dough with our hands until we obtain a firm and manageable dough.
- 3) Shape a cylinder with it approximately 5 cm in diameter.
- 4) With the help of a scraper, cut 8-10 portions.
- 5) Sprinkle a surface with flour and start to stretch the discs with a roller until they reach a very thin thickness. The thinner the dough, the crunchier it will be after baking.

Stuff and bake:

- 1) Preh<mark>eat the oven to 260°C. Line two baking trays with baking paper, set aside.</mark>
- 2) Stuff with rice mixture, 2 tablespoons or so, leaving a little space around the edge.
- 3) To give shape to the pie, fold the dough over the filling and start creating waves from the middle to the ends, helping with your fingers. Place on a tray lined with baking paper.
- 4) Repeat the process with the rest of the pies.
- 5) Bake for 14-15 minutes, they should acquire a slightly golden and crunchy aspect.

While we bake the pies, prepare the egg butter:

- 1) Cut the boiled egg into very small squares and mix with the butter.
- 2) Season and set aside.

Get the cakes out of the oven:

- 1) Remove the pies from the oven and brush with melted butter.
- 2) Let them temper and cover them with the egg butter.

Eskonkatu 1, 20320 Turku



Small Loop (Green)

Distance: 120 km

Recommended time: 1-2 days

Open 14.5-29.8.2021

Great way to spend a weekend, cycling in Finland is safe as cars do keep a good distance and cities provide a lot of cycling roads. Even gravel roads are firm, so grater majority is accessible no matter what kind of bike you have. Download the ferry schedule on your phone before going! You will need cash to pay for the longest ferry but rest of them is free.

Big Loop (Red)

Distance: 250km (~220 on road) Recommended time: 2-5 days

Ferries: 8-9

Open 14.05 - 29.8 2021

One of the most beautiful rides in Southwest Finland. You will have an opportunity to see how archipelago nature change every kilometer and experience small cities on the sea shore. Highly recommend, again only one ferry is under the fee, rest of them for free. Take a tent or book a cottage on the way.
